Signs and Symptoms of Exposure: OVEREXPOSURE TO VAPORS CAN CAUSE EYE IRRITATION, BLURRED VISION, DIZZY SPELLS, IRRITATION, DEFATTING, DERMATITIS

Medical Conditions Generally Aggravated by Exposure: NO KNOWN EFFECTS ON OTHER ILLNESSES.

Emergency First Aid Procedures: **EYES:** FLUSH WITH LARGE AMOUNTS OF WATER LIFTING UPPER AND LOWER LIDS. GET MEDICAL ATTENTION. **SKIN:** REMOVE CONTAMINATED CLOTHES AND WASH SKIN WITH WATERLESS HAND CLEANER OR SOAP AND WATER. **INHALATION:** REMOVE FROM VAPOR IMMEDIATELY. CONTACT A PHYSICIAN. **INGESTION:** DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. CONTACT A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

**Section 7 – Precautions for Safe Handling and Use**

Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled: REMOVE SOURCES OF IGNITION. RECOVER FREE LIQUID. ADD ABSORBENT (SAND, EARTH, ETC) TO SPILL AREA. AVOID BREATHING VAPORS. VENTILATE CONFINED AREAS. KEEP PRODUCT OUT OF SEWERS BY DIKEING OR IMPOUNDING.

Waste Disposal Method: FOLLOW ALL FEDERAL, STATE & LOCAL REGULATIONS. DISPOSE THROUGH A LICENSED WASTE DISPOSAL COMPANY.

Precautions to be Taken in Handling and Storage: KEEP CONTAINERS CLOSED WHEN NOT IN USE. DO NOT STORE OR HANDLE NEAR HEAT, SPARKS, FLAME OR STRONG OXIDANTS. ADEQUATE VENTILATION IS REQUIRED.

Other Precautions: AVOID BREATHING VAPORS. AVOID PROLONGED OR REPEATED CONTACT WITH SKIN. REMOVE CONTAMINATED CLOTHING AND LAUNDRER BEFORE RE-USE. WASH SKIN THOROUGHLY WITH SOAP AND WATER.

**Section 8 – Control Measures**

*Respiratory Protection (Type):* USE HYDROCARBON VAPOR CANISTER OR SUPPLIED AIR RESPIRATORY PROTECTION IN CONFINED OR ENCLOSED SPACES – IF NEEDED.

*Ventilation:*

Local Exhaust: FACE VELOCITY 60 fpm

Mechanical (General):

Special: USE ONLY WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION

Other:

*Protective Gloves:* USE CHEMICAL RESISTANT IF NEEDED TO AVOID REPEATED OR PROLONGED SKIN CONTACT.

*Eye Protection:* SPLASH GOGGLES OR FACE SHIELD WHEN EYE CONTACT MAY OCCUR. HAVE EYE BATH AVAILABLE.

*Other Protective Clothing or Equipment:* USE CHEMICAL RESISTANT APRON OR OTHER CLOTHING TO AVOID CONTINUED SKIN CONTACT.

*Work/Hygienic Practices:* PRACTICE GOOD HOUSEKEEPING.
